<p>TOPIC: What is life like in the Alps?</p> <p>Oak Class will locate the Alps and identify the eight countries that they spread through. They will locate physical and human characteristics in the Alps and research Innsbruck. They will use a variety of data collection methods and compare their local area to Innsbruck. Using all the information that they find out during this topic, they will be able to answer the enquiry question: "What is life like in the Alps?"</p>
