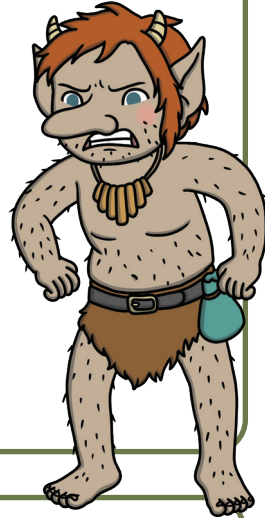


# The Three Billy Goats Gruff

## Home Learning Challenges

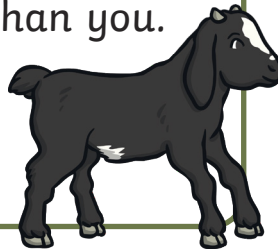
Think about the story of The Three Billy Goats Gruff. The characters in the story all have different feelings during different parts of the story. Can you talk to your grown-up about how you think the troll was feeling and why? How were the Billy Goats feeling when they were on the bridge? What about when they got to the other side?



Make a troll. It could be a puppet, a picture, a collage or a model. Can you bring it in or take a photo to share?

Can you think of a different way the Three Billy Goats Gruff story could end? Write a new ending or draw a picture to show how you would like the story to end.

The Three Billy Goats Gruff are 3 different sizes. Have a look around your house and find something that is bigger than you and something that is smaller than you. Can you make a list to show which items are bigger and which are smaller?



Use books or the Internet to find out 2 facts about goats. Bring them into class to share with your friends.

There are 3 goats in the story. Can you go on a '3 hunt' and look for items in your home that represent the number 3? This could be a numeral on a door, 3 cakes on a plate or 3 dots on a dice. You might like to write down or take photos of different things you see.
